Friday Morning Bible Study

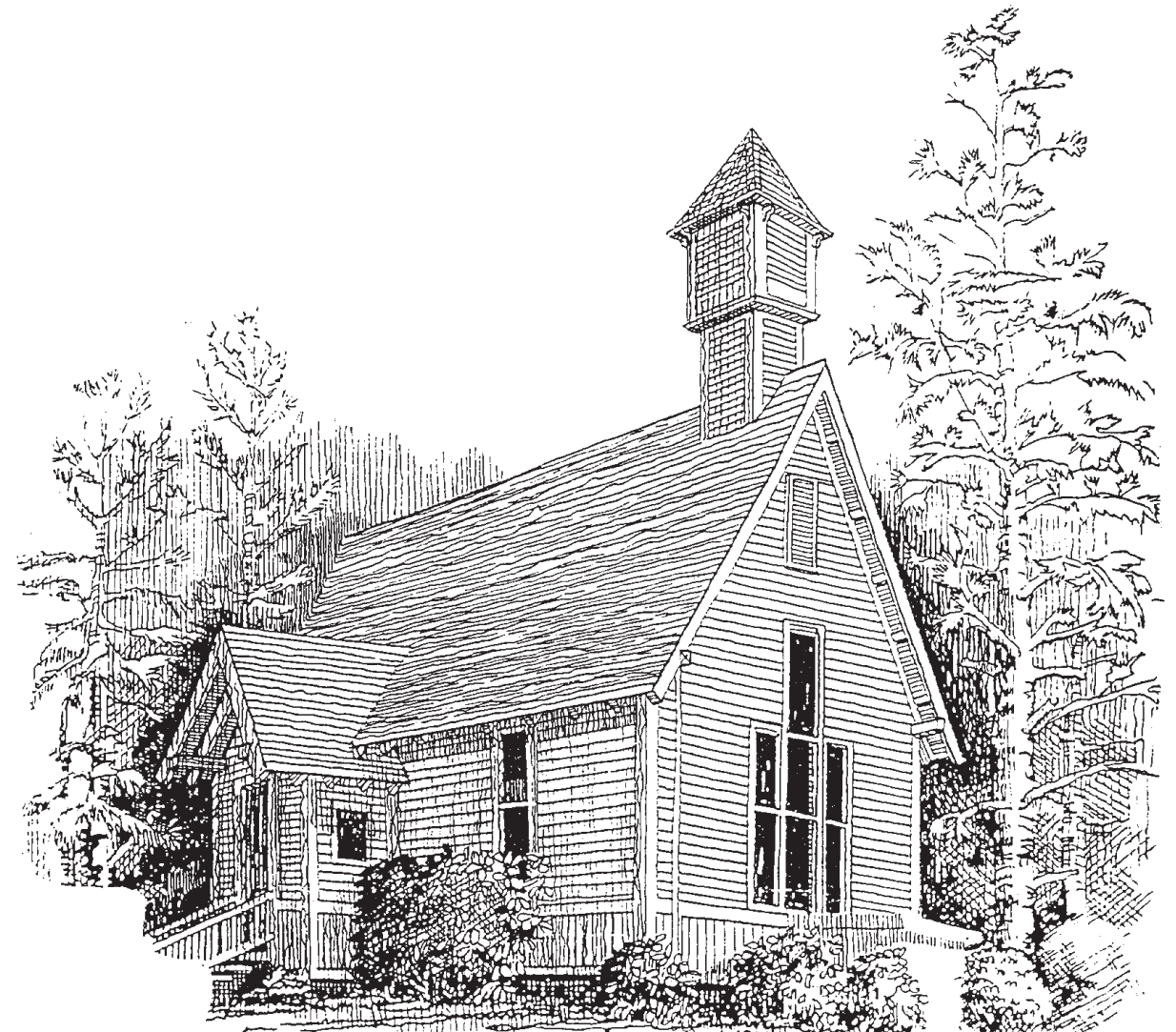
